c. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read:

"Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing dust. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse."

d. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment to read:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.


IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.



Shur Kill Roach Killer will also control ants, silverfish and waterbugs. If kept dry the powder will provide long lasting protection. Shake well before using. After application any powder visible should be carefully brushed into cracks and crevices or removed. Do not use in wet or damp areas.

HOUSEHOLD APPLICATION: Apply liberally behind and under sink, stove, refrigerator, dishwasher, washer and dryer. Remove lower cabinet drawers in kitchen and bath and liberally scatter powder in cabinet wells. Apply into opening around pipes, drains, window sills and door jams. Check baseboards and apply powder into cracks and crevices.

STORAGE: Store only in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse the empty container. Securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.
