Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals:

**CAUTION:** May be harmful if swallowed. Causes moderate eye irritaion. Do not breathe dust or spray mists. May be irritating to nose and throat. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

For Manufacturing, Repackaging or Reformulating Plant Growth Regulators, Herbicides and Fungicides for use on turf, ornamentals, industrial vegetative management, pineapples and uses for the US EPA has approved the required data and/or citations of data that formulator has submitted in support of registration and uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with US EPA requirements. **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**
