C. Change the header "Decontamination" to "First Aid" and revise the first aid instructions as follows:

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:

- Take off contaminated clothing.
- Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF IN EYES:

- Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.
- Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.


D. Under the Environmental Hazards section, change the period behind "estuaries" to a comma in the first sentence, and in the last sentence change the comma behind "authority" to a period.

3. Submit one copy of the final printed label before you release the product for shipment.
