Dear Mr. Mandava:

The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as amended is acceptable provided that you make the following change to the label:

In the *Directions for Use* under the heading *Terrestrial Non-Food*, delete "and paint systems for in-film preservation including paper coatings for indoor, non-food contact uses, glues and adhesives, and metal working fluids against biodeterioration."

As a condition of registration, you must submit or cite data to satisfy the following data gaps in the timeframe specified below:

1. Submit barley field trial data from regions 10 and 11 (along with concurrent storage stability data on barley straw). Submission Due by: December 2011
2. Comply in the timeframe specified with the future Agency Data Call-in for all triazole-derivative active ingredients.
3. Submit a Whole Sediment Toxicity Study for benthic invertebrates. Submission due by: December 2011.
4. Submit Aerobic and Anaerobic Aquatic Metabolism Studies. Submission due by: December 2011.

Terrestrial Food Crops - Foliar Treatment: Barley and Wheat

Terrestrial Non-Food Crops: Roses, Flowers, Ornamental trees, Ornamental shrubs, Groundcovers, Vines and Houseplants

Terrestrial Non-Food (Domestic Outdoor): For preservation of wood-based composite products, wood products intended for above ground and in-ground contact, plastics, coatings, and paint systems for in-film preservation including paper coatings for indoor, non-food contact uses, glues and adhesives, and metal working fluids against biodeterioration.

This product may be used to formulate for any additional uses not listed on this label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with EPA data requirements regarding the support of such use.

Labeling for products formulated from this product must conform to that which is currently registered with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. For specific information on federally registered uses, contact Repar Corporation. Any variance from the federally registered labeling for end-use products containing Tebuconazole will have to be supported by data provided by the formulator.

RESTRICTIONS

Do not package Tebuconazole Technical in metal containers.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PESTICIDE STORAGE

Store in cool, dry place and in such a manner as to prevent cross contamination with other pesticides, fertilizers, food,

and feed. Store in original container and out of the reach of children, preferably in a locked storage area.

Handle an open container in a manner as to prevent spillage. If the container is leaking or material spilled for any reason or cause, carefully sweep material into a pile. Refer to Precautionary Statements on label for hazards associated with the handling of this materials. Do not walk through spilled materials. Dispose of pesticide as directed below.
