Terrestrial Food Crops: Asparagus, Bananas and Plantains, Barley, Beans, Cherries, Corn, Cotton, Cucurbit Vegetables, Garlic, Grapes, Grasses Grown for Seed, Hops, Leafy Brassica Greens, Garden Beets, Lychee, Nectarines, Oats, Okra, Onion, Peaches, Peanuts, Pecan, Soybeans, Sunflower, Turnips and Wheat.

Terrestrial Non-Food Crops: Turf, Roses, Flowers, Ornamental trees, Ornamental shrubs, Ground covers, Vines and Houseplants.

Labeling for products formulated from this product must conform to that which is currently registered with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. For specific information on federally registered uses, contact Repar Corporation at telephone no. 301-384-7290. Any variance from the federally registered labeling for product containing Tebuconazole will have to be supported by data provided by the formulator.

RESTRICTIONS

Do not package Tebuconazole Technical in metal containers.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage

Store in a cool, dry place and in such a manner as to prevent cross contamination with other pesticides, fertilizers, food, and feed. Store in original container and out of the reach of children, preferably in a locked storage area. Handle and open container in a manner as to prevent spillage. If the container is leaking or material spilled for any reason or cause, carefully sweep material into a pile. Refer to Precautionary Statements on label for hazards associated with handling of this material. Do not walk through spilled materials. Dispose of pesticide as directed below.
