
3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

Care should be taken in the use of this product. If accidentally sprayed in the eyes or on exposed skin, wash thoroughly with cold water. If swallowed, immediately drink three to four glasses of milk or water. Do not induce vomiting. Seek immediate medical attention. Avoid accidental discharge of this container. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use Sani-Mist to sanitize precleaned nonporous, nonfood contact environmental surfaces. Adequately clean all surfaces before sanitizing.

Hold container 6 to 8 inches away from surface to be sanitized and spray for 3 to 5 seconds. Spray lightly and evenly on surfaces. Allow the surface to air dry. Treatment does not have to be repeated until the next use.

This product can be used on sites such as: bathroom and public restroom fixtures, toilet seats, telephones, grocery cart handles, counter tops, diaper changing tables, or other nonporous/nonfood contact surfaces.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not store in areas near extreme heat. To dispose of empty container replace cap and please recycle. Do not incinerate or puncture.
