Hold container 6 to 8 inches away from surface to be sanitized and spray for 3 to 5 seconds. Spray lightly and evenly on surfaces. Allow the surface to air dry. Treatment does not have to be repeated until next use.

This product can be used on sites such as: dog kennels, cages, sleeping quarters, leashes, and grooming tools; cat cages, sleeping quarters, litter boxes, and grooming tools; bird cages and perches; rodent cages, and accessories (tread wheels and tunnels); rabbits, ferrets, pot bellied pig's cages, and sleeping quarters; reptiles (iguanas, turtles, and snakes) tanks, and tank liners; and other nonporous/nonfood contact surfaces.
