Under the "Directions for Use" on the second page of the label, look at the Agency's March 11, 1998 "Last Accepted Stamped label" and use that language that is under the "Directions For Use" for this label.

A stamped copy of the accepted labeling is enclosed. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.



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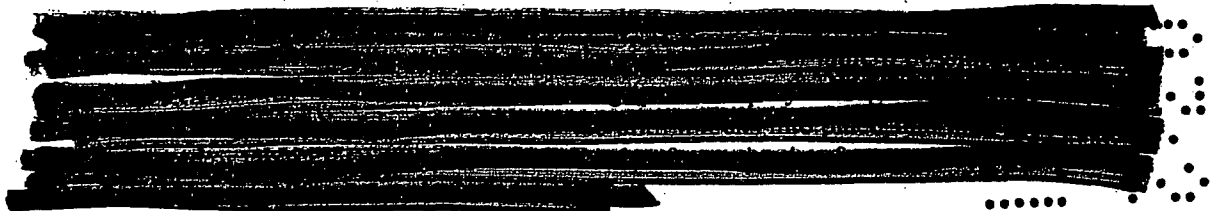
