Statement of Practical Treatment

If Swallowed: Contact a physician or poison control center. Induce vomiting by touching back of the throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person. If In Eyes or On Skin: Flush affected areas with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists. If Inhaled: Remove affected person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Contact a physician if warranted.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

FOR USE ON PETS TO CONTROL FLEAS AND TICKS: Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure that the animal's body is covered, including the legs and under body. While spraying, fluff the hair so that spray will penetrate to the skin. Make sure spray wets thoroughly. Do not spray into eyes, face or genitals. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray on nursing females or pets under six weeks of age.

FOR USE ON PETS TO CONTROL EAR MITES: Place ten drops in each ear and massage. Repeat as necessary.

FOR USE ON LIVESTOCK: To protect cattle, horses and hogs from *Horn Flies*, *House Flies*, *Mosquitoes* and *Gnats*, apply a light mist sufficient to wet the surface of the hair. To control *Stable Flies*, *Horse Flies* and *Deer Flies* apply at the rate of 2 ounces per adult animal, sufficient to thoroughly wet the hair. Repeat treatment daily or at intervals necessary to give continued protection. To control *Blood Sucking Lice* apply to the infested areas of the animal, using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Repeat every 2 to 3 weeks if required.

To control *Poultry Lice* spray roosts, walls and nests or cages thoroughly. This should be followed by spraying over the birds with a fine mist. For control of *Bedbugs* and *Mites* in poultry houses, spray crevices of roost poles, cracks in walls, and cracks in nests where these insects hide.

FOR USE ON PREMISES: To control *Fleas* and *Brown Dog Ticks* thoroughly spray infested areas, pet beds, resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, moldings, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor covering. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Concurrent treatment of animals is recommended. Repeat treatment as needed.
