 - c. Revise the subheading "Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals" to read "Hazards to Humans".
 - d. Revise the Hazards to Humans Statement to read as follows:

CAUTION: May be harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. May cause eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes. Wash thoroughly after handling.

- e. Add a Hazards to Domestic Animals Statement which reads as follows:

Some animals may be sensitive to ingredients in this product. Following treatment, observe your pet for possible signs of sensitivity or adverse reactions to this product. If signs persist, or become more severe, consult a veterinarian immediately.

- f. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment to read as follows:

IF SWALLOWED: Contact a physician or poison control center. Induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person. **IF IN EYES:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. **IF ON SKIN:** Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

- g. Add the statement "To prevent harm to you and your pet, read entire label before use."

- h. Add the statement "Do not use on puppies or kittens under 6 weeks old. Consult your veterinarian before using this product on pregnant or lactating females, and old, sick or debilitated animals."

- i. Delete "Leaves a lustrous coat" and "The pet will have a clear, lustrous coat, free of fleas and ticks."

- j. Revise the phrase "with a product approved for domestic indoor or outdoor use" to read "with a product registered for use in these areas."

3. Submit three copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

In case of infection or skin irritation, discontinue use and consult a veterinarian. **If Inhaled:** Remove affected person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Contact a physician if warranted.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To shampoo and kill Fleas and Ticks, wet the pet's coat with warm water. Starting at the head, work shampoo thoroughly into the hair. Allow the lather to penetrate the fur for five minutes before rinsing. Dry with a towel. The pet will have a clear, lustrous coat, free of fleas and ticks.

Pet bedding and quarters should be treated simultaneously with a product approved for domestic indoor or outdoor use.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets. **DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container; wrap and put in trash.
