INDOORS -or- IN THE HOME

For Flying Insects: *To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats and Wasps: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for an average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. -or- Leave room and keep it closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry.
 -or- Allow room to air-out completely before going back inside. Sweep up fallen insects.

For Crawling Bugs: To Kill Cockroaches, Ants and Crickets: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also, thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests.
 -or- Spray directly on bugs whenever possible. Spray all parts of room where bugs live. For ants, spray doors, around window frames, trails, and other areas where ants enter your home. Use the (yellow) extension tube for hard to reach places -or- cracks and crevices. Special attention should be paid to -or- Spray cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas, baseboards, under kitchen shelves, between cabinets and wherever these pests -or- bugs are suspected of -or- may be hiding. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Sowbugs, Centipedes, Firebrats and Spiders: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. -or- Thoroughly spray all parts of the room where bugs may be hiding or living. Special attention should be paid to -or- Spray cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces -or- areas under sinks, and behind stoves and refrigerators.

To Kill Carpet Beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill exposed forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Rice Weevils, and Saw-Toothed Grain Beetles: Find and destroy infested package foods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Fleas and Ticks in Pet Bedding and Pet Areas: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. To reduce infestation, thoroughly spray the animal's bedding, sleeping quarters, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, local areas of floors, and other resting places until the surface is slightly moist. Treat these areas at the rate of two seconds per linear foot at a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Also spray the entire inside surface of dog houses. Repeat as necessary. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried. DO NOT SPRAY ANIMALS. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to reenter treated areas.

To Treat Flea and Tick Infestation in Rugs and Carpets: Spray rugs and carpets where fleas tend to hide. If used on light or delicate upholstery fabrics, test for potential staining in an inconspicuous place prior to use. Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, in walls and floors, along baseboards, window and door frames. Spray at the rate of one square foot per second. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS: Important: Do not spray on vegetables, fruits or plants you intend to eat.

To Reduce Annoyance of Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Small Flying Moths: Spray area infested with these flying insects. Hold container 18-24 inches from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of 1 to 3 seconds per cubic yard of space while moving away from the treated areas. To reduce annoyance from these pests, treat open porches and patios in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Ants: Hold can about 2 feet from ants. Spray on ant trails, in areas where you see ants, and directly on the colony -or- mound if visible. Use the (yellow) (plastic) extension tube for hard to reach places -or- cracks and crevices. Repeat as necessary.

IN THE GARDEN

Important: Do not use this product on crops or plants you plan to eat. When spraying, hold can about 2 feet from plants. Be careful when spraying new growth on young plants.

For Flying Insects: Spray area where you see bugs, using a slow sweeping motion while moving away from the sprayed areas. Also spray porches and patios. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dissipate before re-entering the area. Repeat as necessary.

***To Kill Ornamental Plant Pests Listed Below or For Ornamental Plant Bugs:** Kills Eastern Tent Caterpillar, Aphids, Leafhopper, White Flies, Spider Mites, Japanese Beetles, Mealybugs, Ants, Caterpillars on Ornamental Cherry, Spirea, Rose, Grape Myrtle, Crabapple, Gardenia, Chrysanthemum, Purple Passion Vine, Peony, Oleander. See spray chart below.

General: When sprayed directly on insects, this spray will kill the insects listed. Caution should be taken when spraying new tender growth on young plants. WHEN SPRAYING, HOLD CAN 18-24 INCHES FROM PLANT.

For best results, spray in the evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Mist the plant lightly. -or- For best results, spray the plant lightly in the evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Use a slow sweeping motion. Avoid wetting foliage -or- leaves with spray. Spray rows at the rate of 1 foot per second. For heavy growth, spray both sides of row. Repeat as needed. Do not spray when temperatures exceed 90°F.
