### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

If used on animals, use only on dogs and cats. May also be used as an area and surface spray. SHAKE BEFORE USE, HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT, APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats and Wasps: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. To Kill Carpet Beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary

To Kill Exposed Forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-Toothed Grain Beetles, and Rice Weevils: Find and destroy infested packaged goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves

have dried. Repeat as necessary.
