TO KILL BEDBUGS: Spray mattresses, particularly around falts and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings, and floors. Allow all treated articles to dry thoroughly before use. Repeat treatment as necessary.

TO CONTROL CLOTHES MOTHS: Remove any infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus, and other storages, directing the spray into cracks, joints, and crevices. After alring, infested articles may be treated lightly, keeping nozzle at least three feet from labric to avoid staining.

TO KILL FLEAS AND BROWN DOG TICKS: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall gracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary.
