Spray on floors, along baseboards in the kitchens and baths, using the extension tube to spray into cracks and crevices. Spray at a rate of 5 seconds per linear foot. Special attention should be paid to areas around refrigerators and entry points such as doors, windows, vents, pipes, etc.

TO KILL SOWBUGS, CENTIPEDES, SILVERFISH, FIREBRATS AND SPIDERS: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks and behind refrigerators.

TO KILL CARPET BEETLES: Spray directly on beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves, and carpet. Allow carpet to dry thoroughly before use. Repeat treatment as necessary.

TO KILL BEDBUGS: Spray mattresses, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray into all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings, and floors. Allow carpet to dry thoroughly before use. Repeat treatment as necessary.

TO CONTROL CLOTHES MOTHS: Remove any infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus, and other storages, directing the spray into cracks, joints, and crevices. After airing, infested articles may be treated lightly, keeping nozzle at least three feet from fabric to avoid staining.

TO KILL FLEAS AND BROWN DOG TICKS: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary.

DO NOT SPRAY ON ANIMALS. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.
