Treating the pool Pools Previously Treated with Chlorinating Chemicals

Check with chlorine test kit for free and combined chlorine prior to the beginning of neutralization. To destroy chlorine, add STOP CHLORE chlorine neutralizer per label directions. Filter overnight.
