The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

- To update "First Aid" statement per PR Notice 2001-1.
- To change the primary brand name to CDB90 ½ Ounce Tablets

## **Conditions**

*Revise the label as follows:* 

- The term "Highly" must precede "Corrosive" below the signal word on the 1. lahel.
- The "Precautionary Hazards" statement should read: Do not breathe dust 2. or spray mists. Irritating to nose and throat. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear protective clothing, rubber gloves goggles, face shield, or safety glasses when handling this product. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or using tobacco.
- Add the statement "Do not reuse empty container" to the Container 3. Disposal section.
