**DIRECTIONS**

To remove visible yellow or mustard algae (of water).

1. Brush walls and floor of pool.
2. Apply 4 oz. of Yellow Algae Remover per 10,000 gallons of water.
3. Superchlorinate by adding 1/2 oz. of chlorine per 10,000 gallons of water.

Swimming may be resumed after 24 hours.

**WEEKLY MAINTENANCE**

To prevent accumulation of yellow or mustard algae (of water).

1. With water temperature below 70°F, add 1/2 oz. of chlorine per 10,000 gallons of water weekly.
2. With water temperature above 70°F, add 1/2 oz. of chlorine per 10,000 gallons of water weekly.
