The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read the entire label and use strictly in accordance with precautionary statements and directions. This product is a granular formula that helps clear away slimy, yellow and mustard algae in swimming pools. When used as directed, this product clears water quickly and can be used in any type of swimming pool. Swimming may be resumed several hours after treatment.

[IMMEDIATE TREATMENT:

To remove visible yellow or mustard algae: (All dosages are for 10,000 gallons [37.8 kL] of water). Brush walls and floor areas affected by yellow algae accumulations. Apply 4 oz. [113.4 g] of this product as close to the affected areas as possible. For severe accumulations, double the above dosage. After algae treatment is applied, the pool should be shocked to oxidize contaminants and inorganic by-products of the pool sanitization process. An appropriate shock product must be used following the directions of that product's label. Swimming may be resumed several hours after treatment.]

[WEEKLY MAINTENANCE TREATMENT:

To prevent accumulation of yellow algae: (All dosages are for 10,000 gallons [37.8 kL] of water). With water temperature over 80°F, add 4 oz.[113.4 g] of this product followed by 1 gallon [3.785 L] of liquid chlorine or 1 pound [453.6 g] of dry chlorine once a week. With a water temperature under 80°F, add 2 oz. [56.7 g] of this product weekly followed by ½ gallon [1.89 L] of liquid chlorine or ½ pound [226.8 g] of dry chlorine.]

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE:

Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area, in well-closed original containers, away from energy sources, acids, bases, and heavy metal salts.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:

pesticide disposal. If contents are contaminated or decomposing, do not reseal container; isolate unsealed container in the open or in a well-ventilated area; flood with large volumes of water if necessary.
