***IMPORTANT:** Do not use this product on Bentgrass and Floratam, a variety of St. Augustine grass. Certain hybrid bermudagrasses vary in tolerance to this product. Temporary discoloration may occur on St. Augustine and Centipede.

- Shake well before use.
- Open spray nozzle.
- Adjust nozzle to provide desired spray pattern.
- Hold spray about 12 inches from weed.
- Aim at center of weed and spray to lightly cover. Do not overspray.
- Rotate nozzle to closed position.
- Weeds begin to die after 12 hours. It may take up to 4 weeks for a weed to completely die.
- If necessary, repeat application after 8 weeks.

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STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate other pesticides, fertilizers, water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
