 - b. The First Aid statement must be organized so the most severe routes of exposure are listed first. Please reorganize the first aid statement accordingly. It should be, If Swallowed, IF in Eyes, If on Skin or Clothing and If Inhaled.
 - c. EPA encourages registrants to include a company telephone number or toll free-hotline number on their pesticide labels in case of emergency.
 - d. Add the following statements near the First Aid Statements:

"Have the product or label with you when calling a Poison Control Center or Doctor or going for treatment". In case of emergency, for additional information call (insert toll free-emergency number).

- f. Add a net content statement to the label which is the weight/volume of the pesticide in the container.
- g. Revise the Environmental Hazards Statement to read as follows:

Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other water unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

- 3. Submit four (4) copies of the revised final printed labeling for the record.

GENERAL INFORMATION

BoraSol-WP is a water soluble inorganic borate salt with termiticidal properties. This product can be used for the pressure treatment.

TARGET ORGANISMS

BoraSol-WP is effective for treatment of wood (and wood-foam composite structural components) against wood-boring insects, including the following termites.

Subterranean Termites

Reticulitermes, Heterotermes,
Coptotermes (Formosan)
Drywood Termites
Kalotermes, Incisitermes
Dampwood Termites
Zootermopsis

BoraSol-PT is recommended for wood materials in accordance with the specific treatment methods described below. BoraSol-PT is effective for interior and exterior wood that will be protected from excessive rain and not in direct contact with soil. Types of wood include, but are not limited to, all types of lumber, logs, and plywood. This product is toxic to termites, but surface etching of treated wood may occur.

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PRESSURE TREATMENT

Pressure treatment of wood should result in a retention of 0.25 lb/ft³ (4.0 kg/m³) DOT (equiv.) in the assay zone specified in AWPA standard C-2. The concentration of the solution must be adjusted to give the correct retention for wood species and size being treated; in general, solutions are in the range of 1-2% DOT (equiv.) (0.083-0.166 lb/gal) w/v. Standards C-1 and C-2 of the American Wood Preservers' Association should be consulted regarding treatment times, pressures and temperatures necessary for various species of wood.

Clean wood should be cut to dimension, dried to less than 25% moisture (as oven dry weight), stickered before treating. If several species are being treated at once, the treatment schedule should be chosen for the most difficult to treat species. If both sapwood and heartwood are included, use the schedule for heartwood to ensure adequate loadings.
