This following labeling, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with comments.

Update First Aid Statement per PR Notice 2001-1

Label Comment

1. The Precautionary Statement must be revised to read as follows:

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Avoid contact with eyes. Wear goggles or safety glasses and chemical resistant rubber gloves when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before use.

General Comments

Note: If this product is being sold in larger containers (i.e. 5 gallons - 55 gallons) the sizes of the containers must be listed in block #4, section III of form 8570-1 and appropriate storage and disposal language for container size. Refer to PR Notice 83-3 for detailed information.

FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not contaminate water by the cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant

other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds that do not contain fish. For maximum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using this product.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 11 to 17 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae. For treatment of freshly cleaned and filled pools add 6 to 11 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and ponds having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 1 to 2 fluid ounces of this product per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned spa, whirlpool, hot tub, decorative fountain or pond, add 0.6 to 1.1 fluid ounces of this product per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 0.2 to 0.4 fluid ounces of this product should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

This product will prevent growth of most algae during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. For pools which have been properly treated during the swimming season and are free of visible algae, add 6 to 10 fluid ounces of this product per 10,000 gallons of water. If at the end of swimming season pools have some visible algae growth, add 12 to 17 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of algaecide throughout the water and the pool be made for maximum effectiveness. If pool is not covered, it may be necessary to repeat the treatment one or more times during the season.

This product is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. This product can be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix this product with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.
