

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DOSAGE RATES:

EVERY THREE MONTHS: add 16 fl. oz. of this product per 10,000 gallons pool water (or 500 mL per 40,000 L) will prevent algae growth in all pool types.

SEVERE ALGAE TREATMENT: add 32 fl. oz. of this product per 10,000 gallons pool water (or 1 Liter per 40,000 L).

GENERAL DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Maintain pool water in the pH range 7.2 to 7.8. Total Alkalinity range 80 ppm to 120 ppm. Adjust pH to 7.2 for severe algae.

2. Ensure that filtration system is working properly and that filtration cycle is adequate.
3. Brush pool regularly.
4. Calculate the volume of this product required for your pool.
5. Add the product directly to deep end of the pool and preferably in front of a water return. Dilute in a bucket of pool water when adding to pools with plaster finishes.

This product must be used along with adequate levels of an EPA registered sanitizer (e.g. chlorine) to control bacteria.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS. HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS.

CAUTION. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. In case of contact immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
