ECOSHARP™ WEED & GRASS KILLER is a postemergent foliar active vegetation management product formulated to contain an organic acid. It is non-selective to green foliage and non-residual in soil. ECOSHARP WEED & GRASS KILLER is for the control of herbaceous broadleaf and grassy weeds on non-cropland areas, such as railroad rights-of-way, power stations, industrial sites and driveways; around farm buildings, storage areas and tank farms; and golf courses; and in fence rows and vacant lots.

ECOSHARP WEED & GRASS KILLER is fast acting. Foliar contact results in rapid burndown and control of annual weeds and grasses and top growth reduction of herbaceous perennial weeds and grasses (see tables below). Retreatment is required for control of established perennial weeds.

Do not allow contact with desirable plants. Overspray or drift will injure or kill contacted vegetation.

FOR EARLY SEASON ANNUAL WEED CONTROL:

When weeds are small (3 to 5 leaf) and actively growing, mix a spray solution consisting of 1 gallon of ECOSHARP WEED & GRASS KILLER for each 3 gallons of water. Ensure adequate mixing. Spray unwanted vegetation to point of wetness.

SPOT TREATMENT APPLICATION: Use a single nozzle or a handgun applicator to direct spray and

thoroughly wet undesirable foliage. Retreatment of perennial weed growth will be required for control.

BROADCAST APPLICATION: Use EcoSharp Weed & Grass Killer for broad cast application at the rate of 75 gallons to 125 gallons/acre. Thorough coverage is necessary to achieve desirable control. For dense populations and heavy foliage, use the higher spray volume to insure adequate coverage. Apply with flat fan nozzles and sufficient pressure to achieve required coverage.

FOR CONTROL OF LARGER ANNUALS AND BURNDOWN OF PERENNIAL WEED GROWTH:

Mix a spray solution consisting of 1 gallon of product to each 2.25 gallons of water. Use an application system and solution volume that will ensure thorough coverage of unwanted vegetation. Best results with these larger weeds will be achieved by spot treatment.

Best results are achieved from spring/early summer applications to actively growing young weeds. Weeds that are mature, dormant, or hardened due to moisture stress are more tolerant of herbicide treatments. Only contacted vegetation will be affected. Rainfast within one hour of application.

Avoid application to reactive metals such as aluminum, tin, iron, or items such as fencing or lawn furniture in order to prevent staining, mottling, or otherwise interfering with finished metal surfaces. In case of contact, rinse sprayed surface with water.
