The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. Under PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS add the following heading and text:

.....PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE).....
Applicators and other handlers must wear: Appropriate protective eyewear such as goggles or face shields. Long-sleeved shirt and long pants, waterproof gloves and shoes plus socks. Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions exists for PPE use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE seperately from other laundry.

2. Under DIRECTIONS FOR USE following the first statement add the following text:

.....Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application.

3. The CSF dated 2/18/98 for the basic formulation is acceptable and supersedes the Basic CSFs dated 8/8/97 and 10/14/97. This information has been inserted in the file for the subject product.



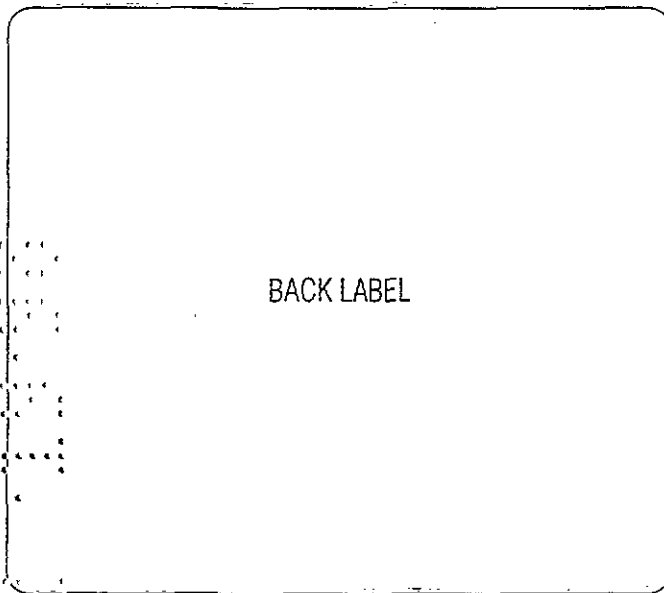

Nature's Glory™ Weed & Grass Killer is a foliar active weed control product which contains vinegar as the active ingredient and extracts from lemon juice as one of the irritants. It is non-selective to both broadleaf and grassy weeds and is recommended for non-food areas such as borders, driveways, sidewalks, around mature tree bases, around buildings, in fence rows, in greenhouses, and around flower beds.

Nature's Glory™ Weed & Grass Killer is fast acting. Foliar contact results in rapid desiccation and control of annual weeds and grasses, and top growth reduction of herbaceous perennial weeds and grasses (see Tables on pg. 4). Re-treatment is required for control of established perennial weeds.

FOR EARLY SEASON ANNUAL WEED CONTROL: When weeds are small (3 to 5 leaf) and actively growing, apply Nature's Glory™ Weed & Grass Killer to the foliage of the weeds, making sure that all of the foliage is wet. Thorough coverage is necessary to achieve desirable control.

Nature's Glory™ Weed & Grass Killer is fast acting. It can be applied up to one hour before rainfall and still be effective. If it rains less than one hour after treatment, determine if the treated leaves are showing symptoms. If symptoms are not obvious, wait until the leaves dry and re-treat.

FOR CONTROL OF LARGER ANNUALS AND BURNDOWN OF PERENNIAL WEED GROWTH: Larger annual weeds and perennials are more difficult to control and may require re-treatment. Treat initially as recommended above and repeat if new growth of leaves appear. Thorough coverage of all green foliage is necessary to achieve desirable control.

Best results are achieved from spring/early summer applications to actively growing young weeds. Weeds that are mature, dormant, or hardened due to moisture stress are more tolerant of herbicide treatments. Only contacted vegetation will be affected. Rainfall within one hour of application will reduce degree of control.

Avoid application to reactive metals such as aluminum, tin, iron, or items such as fencing or lawn furniture in order to prevent staining, mottling, or otherwise interfering with finished metal surfaces.
