


c. Revised the Statement of Practical Treatment to read:

If in Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

If on Skin: Wash with plenty of water. Get medical attention.

Sugar ants are usually found in kitchens and bathrooms, and will often appear to be randomly searching for food. ALL BAIT PRODUCTS WILL WORK BEST WHEN COMPETING SOURCES OF FOOD ARE SEALED UP AND PUT AWAY. This product is specially designed for use on Ghost ants, Tapinoma melanocephalum and other sugar feeding ants.

PRE-BAITING: After locating foraging sugar ants, present them with a 1/2 inch line of OutSmart. In most instances, the ants will quickly recruit more foragers, and in 10-20 minutes, should form a trail to where they are entering the room. Do not spray near the pre-bait placement. Technicians should make a note of the entry locations. A follow up treatment of these entries with a non-repellent dust is recommended.

BAITING: Bait the ants close to where they are entering the room. To maximize the amount of feeding surface, the bait placements should be made in THIN 1/8" lines, 2-3 inches long. Use 1 - 3 bait lines per ant entry point. Once baiting is completed, lightly blow on the ants feeding on the pre-bait spot to disperse them, then wipe up the pre-bait spot. Any bait remaining after 24 hours, should be removed with warm water and paper towel. Rebait at 5-7 day intervals as needed.

NOTE: Results are enhanced when the same procedure is used to bait the exterior surface of the structure.

OutSmart's thick, no-drip formula allows easy baiting up and away from counter surfaces, out of customers sight, and in areas inaccessible to children and pets. OutSmart can be used on vertical or horizontal surfaces including, but not limited to the edges and tops of cupboards, cabinets, along door and window frames, and corners where the wall and ceiling meet. Avoid treating readily visible unfinished or porous surfaces as some watermarking may occur. Do not use in the edible product areas of food handling establishments, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs
