Under the heading FOR SANITIZATION/TREATMENT OF INFECTIOUS MEDICAL WASTE, revise the sentence "Enchlor 25 is approved for use in the Technology 2100 Hospital waste treatment system for the treatment of infectious hospital waste", to read: "Enchlor 25 is recommended for use in the Encore 2100 Medical Waste Treatment System (Infectious Waste Processor [IWP]) for the sanitization/treatment of infectious medical waste".

Your Technology 2100 Representative can guide you in the method of application. For use directions, see the Encore-2100 Medical Waste Treatment System *Safety and Operations Manual*.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
