- As a preventative, apply (Neem Oil RTU) (this product) on a 7 to 14 day schedule until the potential for disease development is no longer present. Spray to run off. Complete coverage of all plant tissue is necessary for control.

BEFORE USE:

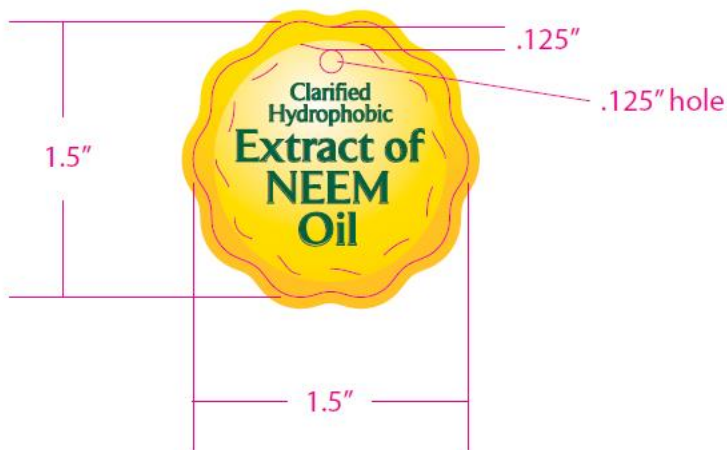
