

Attracts and kills the Olive Fruit Fly (*Bactrocera oleae*) using a target device for season long control in olive orchards.

This package contains 42 devices, enough to treat 1 acre of olive orchard. 14 of the devices contain the ingredients in statement A below and 28 devices contain the ingredients in statement B below. All 42 devices must be used in combination to treat 1 acre to obtain season long control of the Olive Fruit Fly.

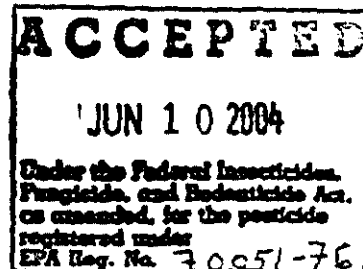

Directions for Using Attract and Kill Target Device

This package contains 42 Attract and Kill Target Devices. All 42 devices must be applied to 1 acre of olive orchard to obtain season long protection against olive fly attack to olive fruit. Wear gloves when hanging the device.

Use Rate: Apply all 42 of the Target Devices per acre as follows:

Hang each device on an olive tree as follows:

- Apply devices before olive fruit remaining from previous season becomes susceptible to egg laying or before the first attack of new fruit of the season. Contact your local agricultural extension specialist for guidance on olive fly activity in your area.
- This package contains 42 devices, enough to treat 1 acre of olive orchard. 14 of the devices contain the Olive fly pheromone, insecticide, and feeding attractant (ingredients "A") and 28 devices contain the insecticide and feeding attractant (ingredients "B"). All 42 devices must be used in combination to treat 1 acre to obtain season long control of the Olive Fruit Fly. Apply the devices so that for every three trees treated, two trees receive the "B" device and one tree receives the "A" device, i.e. every third tree should receive one of the "A" devices.
- Hang the device in the tree on a branch that is not likely to break or be pruned before the end of the season. Hang the device in the tree as high as practical.

- Hang the device by sliding it over the branch so that the branch is in the center of the device, and hook using the tab attachments. When attached properly, the device will form a cone shape around the branch with the lures on the inner surface of the cone. Insure that the lures are on the inner side of the cone as attached to the tree branch.



STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Wrap device in newspaper and discard in trash at an approved disposal facility.
