

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Directions for Use

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Note: Before using this product, make sure the package size you have purchased is correct. The treatment area for this particular package is listed on the front panel. If the size does not match the area to be treated, exchange for the appropriate package size of Aseptrol Dry Carpet Sanitizer 71.

Before applying this product, check the carpet for wetness. If the carpet is wet, dry thoroughly before use in order to achieve maximum product performance.

Open the package and apply a uniform layer of the powder on the surface at a coverage of 2½- 5 grams per square foot. Discard any unused material in the outdoor trash, preferably in a well-ventilated area. Allow the powder to stand for one hour and then vacuum up from the carpet. After the treated area is vacuumed, immediately dispose the contents of the vacuum bag in the outdoor trash, preferably in a well-ventilated area.
