DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Treats up to 30 gal (120 l) of water.
No aftertaste.

Use Instructions:

- 1) Prior to treatment, clean and disinfect the water storage container.
- 2) Place 7 drops of Water Treatment CD (Part A) and 7 drops ACTIVATOR (phosphoric acid) Part B) in a clean cup or mixing cap.
- 3) Let the solution react for 5 minutes.
- 4) Fill the container with 1 quart (1 liter) of water and add contents of cup or cap.
- 5) Shake and let stand for 15 minutes.
- 6) If water is to be stored for a long-period of time, the water container should be sufficiently sealed to prevent outside contamination and direct sunlight. If proper procedures are not taken, additional treatments may be necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Securely wrap original containers in several layers of newspaper and dispose in trash.
