

### Shoes:

[Step 1:] Tear open the foil pouch immediately prior to use and remove the (5 grams sachet) (shoe deodorizer pouch). Place the (sachet) (shoe deodorizer pouch) inside shoes each night after wearing or when shoes are not in use. Remove the (sachet) (shoe deodorizer pouch) before wearing shoes. ### Closets/Laundry Hampers and Bags/Drawers:

### Gym Lockers:

Tear open the foil pouch immediately prior to use and remove the (50) (100) (200) gram (sachet) (deodorizing pouch). Place anywhere in the boat's cabin. Each (sachet) (deodorizing pouch) will treat to (100) (200) (400) ft<sup>3</sup> of cabin space for up to 2 months.

### Athletic Bags:

Tear open the foil pouch immediately prior to use and remove the 5 gram (sachet) (deodorizing pouch). Place the (sachet) (deodorizing pouch) anywhere within the bag. Each (sachet) (deodorizing pouch) will treat up to 2 ft<sup>3</sup> for up to 2 months.

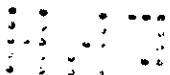
### Trash Cans:

Tear open the foil pouch immediately prior to use and remove the (5) (10) (20) (50) gram (sachet) (deodorizing pouch). Place the (sachet) (deodorizing pouch) anywhere in the can. Each (sachet) (deodorizing pouch) will treat (for) up to 2 months.

### Trash Bags:

Tear open the foil pouch immediately prior to use and remove the (5) (10) (20) (50) gram (sachet) (deodorizing pouch). Place the (sachet) (deodorizing pouch) anywhere in the bag. Each (sachet) (deodorizing pouch) will treat up to 1 week.
