DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not cut or tear open individual (sachet) (deodorizer pouch) (shoe deodorizer pouch) contained within the foil pouch.

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USE INSTRUCTIONS

Refrigerators / (and) (Freezers):

Tear open the foil pouch immediately prior to use and remove the (5) (10) (20) (50) gram (sachet) (deodorizing pouch). Hang or place the (sachet) (deodorizing pouch) anywhere within the refrigerator. Each sachet will treat up to 2 months.

NOTE: This product can only be used in commercial (non-residential) refrigerators that do not store food.

Gym Lockers:

Tear open the foil pouch immediately prior to use and remove the (5) (20) gram (sachet) (deodorizing pouch). Hang or place the (sachet) (deodorizing pouch) anywhere within the locker. Each (sachet) (deodorizing pouch) will treat up to 10 ft³ of locker space for up to 2 months.

Automobiles:

Tear open the foil pouch immediately prior to use and remove the (10) (20) gram (sachet) (deodorizing pouch). Hang or place the (sachet) (deodorizing pouch) anywhere within the vehicle. Each (sachet) (deodorizing pouch) will treat up to a midsize/large size car for up to 2 months.

Athletic Bags:

Tear open the foil pouch immediately prior to use and remove the 5 gram (sachet) (deodorizing pouch). Place the (sachet) (deodorizing pouch) anywhere within the bag. Each (sachet) (deodorizing pouch) will treat up to 2 ft³ for up to 2 months.

Trash Cans (outdoor only):

Tear open the foil pouch immediately prior to use and remove the (5) (10) (20) (50) gram (sachet) (deodorizing pouch). Place the (sachet) (deodorizing pouch) anywhere in the can. Each (sachet) (deodorizing pouch) will treat (for) up to 2 months.
