CSR-1 is a breakthrough technology (patent pending) that releases chlorine dioxide on a controlled basis. The chlorine dioxide inhibits the growth of bacteria and fungi that form slime and cause malodors in ice machines.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area. Do not store at elevated temperatures. Discard used sachet in trash.

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Use Instructions

Ice Machines

1. Access the ice chamber following the manufacturer's instructions and dispose of any used CSR-1 sachets.
2. Clean and sanitize the ice chamber following the manufacturer's cleaning instructions.
3. Open the foil pouch containing the CSR-1 sachet and hang or place the sachet in the ice chamber out of direct contact with water or ice. Consult the table below as a guideline for selecting the appropriate dosage.
Note: The amount of CSR-1 required is based on the amount of ice produced and depends upon the specific design of the ice machine and actual condition of use.
4. Reassemble the ice machine and resume ice making following the manufacturer's instructions.
5. Repeat the process monthly or as often as necessary.
