Aseptrol-SE Water Purifier Tablets are for use by campers, hikers, militaries, emergency organizations, and anyone needing to drink water of questionable microbiological quality. Effective against bacteria, viruses and cysts, such as *Cryptosporidium* and *Giardia*.

Since Aseptrol-SE Water Purifier Tablets are effective against bacteria, viruses and cysts there is no need to use a water filter.

Directions for Use

For the Control of Bacteria, Viruses and Cysts

Use Aseptrol-SE Water Purifier Tablets to kill bacteria, viruses and cysts (*Cryptosporidium parvum* and *Giardia muris*) in contaminated waters. TO USE: Remove the 250 mg (400 mg) Aseptrol-SE Water Purifier Tablet from its foil packaging and quickly insert the tablet into 625 ml (1000 ml or 1 liter) or 21 fl. oz. (34 fl.oz) of contaminated water. Allow to react for 4 hours, in an area away from sunlight, in order to generate a use-solution of 4 ppm chlorine dioxide. The treated water is now ready for drinking.

Storage and Disposal

Store in a cool, dry area away from sunlight and heat and in an area inaccessible to children. Place empty foil pouch in trash.
