

Directions for Use

For the Control of Bacteria, Viruses and Cysts

Use Aseptrol-SE Water Purifier Tablets to kill bacteria, viruses and cysts (*Cryptosporidium parvum* and *Giardia muris*) in contaminated water. TO USE: Remove the {250 mg (400 mg)} [Aseptrol-SE Water Purifier Tablet] [tablet] from its foil packaging [with knife or scissors] and quickly insert [the tablet] into [625 ml (1000 ml or 1 liter) or 21 fl. oz.
