*"Amount of Chlorine Dioxide Generated in Water = 0.02%"*



**General Information**

**Directions for Use**

1. Clean reservoir and delivery tube to remove debris using mild soap and warm water. [We recommend CamelBak's Cleaning Brush Kit™.] Rinse thoroughly.
