

 Use Aseptrol Tablet GC to improve the taste control odor and prevent slime growth and microbial contamination in potable drinking water that is stored or present in drinking water coolers

TO USE Remove the 250 mg tablet from its foil packaging and quickly insert the tablet into 4 quarts (1 gallon) of contaminated water Allow to react for 15 minutes in an area away from sunlight in order to generate a use solution of 1 ppm chlorine dioxide
