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**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**USE ASEPTROL S10-Tab CT TO CONTROL THE GROWTH OF BACTERIA, FUNGI, ALGAE AND BIOFILM DEPOSITS IN COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL RECIRCULATING COOLING WATER SYSTEMS.**

**WHEN APPLYING WEEKLY:**

1. For each 1,000 gallons of cooling water, add to the tower sump between 10 -250 grams (0.35 – 8.8 oz.) of Aseptrol S10-Tab CT to achieve a residual chlorine dioxide concentration between 0.1-0.5 ppm. Repeat application at least weekly.
2. Sample the cooling water at the circulating pump discharge and, if the chlorine dioxide residual does not reach 0.1 ppm, increase the addition rate as needed.

**MONTHLY REMEDIATION OF SYSTEM:**

1. For each 1,000 gallons of cooling water, add to the tower sump between 250 – 750 grams (8.8 – 26.5 oz.) of Aseptrol S10-Tab CT to achieve a residual chlorine dioxide concentration between 0.5 – 0.8 ppm. Repeat application monthly.
2. Sample the cooling water at the circulating pump discharge and, if the chlorine dioxide residual does not reach 0.5 – 0.8 ppm, increase the amount of Aseptrol S10-Tab CT as needed.

(If container size is 5 lbs or less, add the following statement:)

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Store this product in a cool, dry area away from direct sunlight and heat to avoid deterioration and in an area inaccessible to children. Place empty pouch or blister pack and container in plastic bag and discard in trash.

(If container size is greater than 5 lbs, add the following statement:)

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
