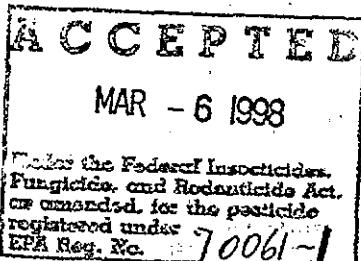

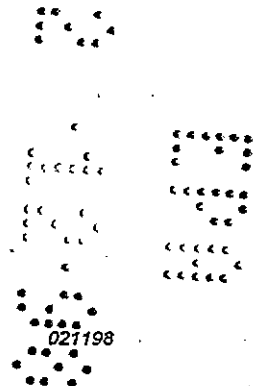

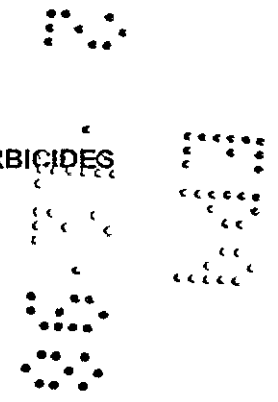

GAME STOP should be applied to foliage and twigs of trees, shrubs, and ornamental plants which are fed upon by rabbits and deer. For best results, mix 1 quart of **GAME STOP** with 1 quart of water (1:1 dilution) Spray the diluted mixture on the plants which you desire to protect from feeding For best results, spray vegetation until wet For broadcast applications, use a volume of 75 gallons to 125 gallons of diluted **GAME STOP**. Thorough coverage is necessary to achieve desired repellency. For dense population and heavy foliage, use the higher spray volume to insure adequate coverage. Only vegetation contacted by **GAME STOP** will be protected. Therefore, during periods of rapid growth, **GAME STOP** should be applied at two-week intervals. During periods of slower growth, such as in the Fall, **GAME STOP** should be applied at four-week intervals. In dormant periods, a single application of **GAME STOP** will be effective Do not make more than fifteen applications per season Rainfall which occurs before drying of **GAME STOP** will reduce the degree of control.
