Cartons may be used to store dry foods without a surface containing free fat or oil. Cartons are not to be used for storage of aqueous or fatty foods, or those dry foods which have a surface containing free fat or oil.

To use, remove folding cartons from the shipping container. Fill and seal REPELKOTE™ IC Cartons using procedures and equipment used for other folding cartons. For best results, use cartons within three months of date of manufacture.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Carton Storage	For maximum effectiveness, keep cartons wrapped in the original shipping container until ready for use.
Carton Disposal	Use normal methods of disposal. Cartons may be recycled, disposed of in a sanitary landfill, or incinerated (if allowed by state and local authorities).
Container Disposal	Shipping containers may be recycled, disposed of in a sanitary landfill, or incinerated (if allowed by state and local authorities).
