TICK-EX EC is composed of spores of the arthropod pathogenic fungus *Metarhizium anisopliae* Strain F52 on a grain matrix. The spores of *Metarhizium anisopliae* attach to the surface of the arthropod, germinate and begin to grow. It will penetrate the exoskeleton of the arthropod and grow very rapidly inside the arthropod, causing the arthropod to die. It usually takes about one week, once the arthropod is exposed for death to occur.

# **APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

Apply TICK-EX EC to residential and institutional lawns and landscape perimeters. Apply at a rate of 2.0 to 3.0 fluid ounces of TICK-EX EC per 1000 ft<sup>2</sup>. Use higher label rates when pest pressure is expected to be high. Apply using a minimum of 4 gallons of water per 1000 ft<sup>2</sup>. Do not apply at pressures above 200 psi. Do not tank mix with fungicides.
