Dear Mr. Dean:

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Please disregard our letter dated August 1, 1997. The appropriate signal word for all metam-sodium products is DANGER/PELIGRO. Thank you for bringing this to our attention. The Agency has completed the reviews for the label amendment to add the sewers use and the product chemistry and acute toxicology data reviews. The results are as follows:

- 1. The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable subject to the following conditions:
 - a. Add the following statements to the "HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS" section of the **PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**:

"May be fatal if absorbed through the skin." and "Causes moderate eye irritation."

- b. Under ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS, add as the first statement "This product is toxic to fish."
- c. Check the temperature in the **STORAGE** section to verify that it is correct.
- d. Modify the first sentence in the **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL** section to read "Pesticide wastes are toxic." Recycled Recyclable • Printed with Vegetable Oll Based Inks on 100% Recycled Paper (40% Postconsumer)

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e. Please submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release of the product for shipment constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

- The revised data (MRID 44459101) submitted on the description of the production process (Guideline No. 830.1620) for sodium N-methyldithiocarbamate are acceptable. The data (MRID 44477001) submitted on the analytical method to verify certified limits (Guideline No. 830.1800) satisfy the data requirements of 40 CFR sec. 158.180 and are acceptable. Please refer to the enclosed reviews dated 03/04/98 and 03/09/98 for specific comments.
- 3. In addition, acute toxicity data (MRIDs 42808301, 42819001 42819002) and found them to be acceptable. Please refer to the enclosed review dated December 16, 1997 for specific comments.
