Your revised Basic Confidential Statement of Formula
(CSF) and label dated August 26, 1998

Dear Mr. Dean,

The Basic CSF referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable and supersedes all previously accepted Basic formulas. A copy of the Basic CSF dated August 26, 1998 has been placed in our file for the subject product. A copy of the Technical Review Branch review is attached.

The amended labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the following changes to the label:
 - a. Change the Spanish language that occurs just above the heading "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS" to the following standard statement (which can be found on page 8-5 of the Label Review Manual):

"Si usted no entiende la etiqueta, busque a alguien para que se la explique a usted in detalle. (If you do not understand the label, find someone to explain it to you in detail.)"
 - b. Change the heading "INSTRUCTIONS FOR FORMULATION" to "DIRECTIONS FOR USE", per the requirement on pages 11-1 and 11-2 in the Label Review Manual.

- c. Change the two occurrences of "reasonable" in the "NOTICE:" section to "reasonably".
2. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration may be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Formulators using this product are responsible for obtaining EPA registrations for their formulated products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Avoid contact with other pesticides, seeds, fertilizers or feed stuffs. Do not use in equipment or in containers in which you have handled or will handle other agricultural chemicals unless thoroughly cleaned.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticides wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal law.
