


DIRECTIONS FOR USE

STORAGE

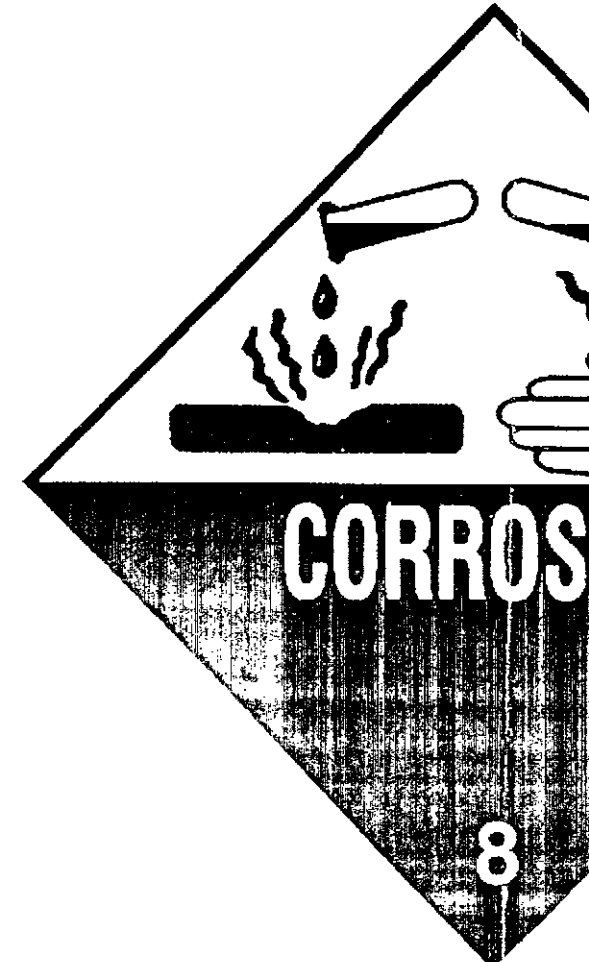
