

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

**SEALIFE 1000** is an anti-fouling marine paint which provides protection to hulls in both salt and fresh water.

This paint has a unique, environmentally compatible formulation. It contains no silicones, arsenic, tributyl tin, lead, mercury, or toxic metals. It does not allow algae, fungi, marine plant life or shellfish (barnacles, mussels, etc.) to attach to it due to its formulation and silky-smooth surface.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

PREPARATION

A clean, dry surface is recommended. For maximum anti-fouling protection, surface should be clean, dry and solid. However, **SEALIFE 1000** can be applied on old paint provided the surface is sound. Undercoating is not needed.

Stir thoroughly. Use with adequate ventilation.
