On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. Make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:
 - a. Add the phrase, "EPA Reg. No. 70228-1".
 - b. The headings, Active Ingredients and Inert Ingredients must be aligned to the same margin and be of equal type size and prominence.
 - c. On the front panel of the outer package label, correct the reference to the accompanying manufactures recommendations so that the statement reads as follows: " Refer to accompanying booklet for complete precautions and directions for use."
 - d. Add the following statement to the front panel of the outer package: " Do not remove packages from container except for immediate use. "

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e. On the back panel of the outer package label, add the phrase, within 3 to 7 days to the third sentence so that it reads as follows: "Destroys entire colonies within 3 to 7 days. "

f. Relocate the livestock grazing statements from their present location in the Environmental Hazards section to the more appropriate location under the Specific Directions heading.

3. It is understood that each of the individual unit packets bears the required minimum labeling which would be identical to the submitted front panel of the outer package label with the exception of the net contents statement. A product distributed in unit packages must bear a label on both the unit package and the outer container.

4. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is in violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, and clothing. Avoid breathing dust or spray mist. When handling this product, wear chemical resistant gloves, long-sleeved shirt and long pants, and shoes plus socks. Wash the outside of the gloves with soap and water before removing. Apply with the wind to your back. Do not use if wind speeds are over 10 mph. Do not allow children or pets to come into contact with treated surfaces until sprays have dried.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, give a large amount of water to drink, make person vomit, and call a physician or the Poison Control Center. In case of eye contact, wash eyes with fresh water for 15 minutes. If irritation continues, call a physician.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to birds. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Cover or soil-incorporate spills. This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to bloom-crops or weeds if bees are visiting treatment area. Do not allow livestock to graze in treated areas. Do not feed treated grass to livestock.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL:

STORAGE: Once this packet is opened, use all of the product as directed. Do not attempt to reseal for future use. Store in a cool dry place, in original container, preferably in a locked storage area.

DISPOSAL: Empty, or partially filled packets may be disposed of by securely wrapping original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

SPECIFIC DIRECTIONS:

1. IMPORTED FIRE ANTS, Red Harvester Ants, and Pavement Ants in home lawns and around ornamental plantings. Sprinkle 1 packet of dry powder over each mound. For best results, apply when ants are active. DO NOT WATER IN. Repeat treatment if ants reappear.
2. Sod Webworms, Greenbug, and Leafhoppers on Home Lawns: Use a hose-end or tank type sprayer. Spray when insects are present or damage is first noticed. Apply 1 packet per 2 gallons of water. Apply 6 gallons of spray per 1000 sq.ft. Repeat if reinfestation occurs.
