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- f. Worker exposure studies; to the extent that these studies apply to seed treatment, required studies are covered by citeall
- 2. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 4.
 - a. Groundwater monitoring; applicant may have to share the costs of a user educational program if groundwater monitoring detects metalaxyl levels at or above 400 ppb
- 3. Make the following label changes:
 - a. Revise the EPA Registration number to read "EPA Reg. No.70252-8" before you release the product for shipment.
 - b. Under "forage legumes" the list should read "...lespedeza, beans..." and "...peas (for forage)..."
 - c. Under "seed and pod vegetables" split out peas that use the higher dosage for Pythium damping off and systemic downy mildew and indicate the dosage as 0.50. For the remainder of the seed and pod vegetables the dosage rate should be 0.25.
 - d. Under "sorghum" split out the 0.5 dosage rate for nondisease resistant cultivars and revise the dosage rate for disease resistant cultivars to 0.25.
 - e. Under "soybeans" delete the dash in Phytophthora.
 - f. Under "corn" for export and "millet" for export reduce dosage rates to 0.49.
 - g. Under "peas" for export lower the dosage rate to 1.0.
 - h. Under "sorghum" for export split out the dosage rate for systemic downy mildew at 1.5 and revise the dosage for Pythium to 0.5.
 - i. Under "sunflowers" for export lower the dosage rate to 3.0.
 - j. Delete "(Revision 1, 11/26/97)" under the product name.
- 4. Submit production information (pounds or gallons produced) for this product for the fiscal year in which the seed treatment use is conditionally registered, in accordance with FIFRA Section 29. The fiscal year begins October 1, and ends September 20. The product information must be submitted to the Agency no later than November 15, following the end of the preceding fiscal year. This information must be submitted to:

- 5. Submit two copies of the revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
- 6. Per our earlier discussion we request that within 10 business days from the date of this registration you withdraw your applications for registration of the six metalaxyl-containing enduse products: Metalaxyl FL Seed Treatment Fungicide (file symbol 70252-E), Metalaxyl LS Fungicide (file symbol 70252-T), Kodiac(TM) A-T Fungicide (file symbol 70252-A), Metalaxyl Dry Seed Protectant Fungicide (file symbol 70252-L), Prevail(R) Metalaxyl-Terrachlor(R)-Vitavax(R) Fungicide (file symbol 70252-G), and Metalaxyl-Terrachlor(R) Dust Seed Treatment (file symbol 70252-U).

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

The revised CSF submitted on December 2, 1997 is acceptable.
