- b. Add to the use directions that "all surfaces must be cleaned before sanitizing (no soil load was added to the inoculums during testing).
- c. Remove food contact surfaces from the proposed label. Efficacy data was generated for non-food contact surfaces. For microwave ovens and appliances, use sites are limited to the exterior surfaces.
- d. Remove the claim "gentle" from the proposed label, as it implies safety.
- e. ATCC designation numbers are required in one of the following locations:
 - on the data matrix
 - on the master label (as optional text) with the listing of the organisms claimed; or
 - as the final page of master label (as optional text)
- f. The storage and disposal section must be revised to comply with PR Notice 2007-4.

The Storage Stability and Corrosion study must be submitted within one (1) year from the date of the Notice of Registration. Refer to the enclosed copies of the product chemistry and acute toxicity reviews for your files.
