
e. Revise the Individually Wrapped Tablet Label by adding the following statement to the directions for use section: "*See pouch for complete directions for use.*"

- 1) Clean unit prior to use
- 2) For every 1 gallon of water, add 1 tablet to your water tank once a week. The tablet will dissolve in 5-7 minutes. Replace tank and operate as instructed in owner's manual.
- 3) Clean your humidifier as instructed by the manufacturer.
