Irgasan PA is a manufacturing use (MP) bacteriostatic agent for formulating use only. Formulators using this product must obtain appropriate EPA registrations to support their products. Not for Diaper Laundry Application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store below 130°F. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Wastes resulting from use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of liner in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities. Drum cannot be reused, dispose of in the same manner.

For minor spills, shovel into an approved disposal container; vacuum contaminated areas. Avoid creating dusty conditions. Take special care to avoid contamination of equipment and facilities during clean up procedures and disposal of wastes.
